Harbour Island is located on the Northeastern (Atlantic) side of North Eleuthera, which is itself due East from Nassau. Eleuthera separates the rough waters of calm turquoise of Exuma Sound. It's Window Bridge. Dunmore Town, the only town on Harbour Island, was once known for shipbuilding and sugar (and rum smuggling during prohibition) but now boasts a hospitality economy which is perfectly suited to the hospitable nature of its residents.

Harbour Island ("Briland" to locals) is famous for having the friendliest people in the Bahamas—residents proudly maintain the island's original welcome sign that states "Home of Friendly People."
